Rules – 2024-2025 Lower Delaware Singles & Doubles Tournament

1. All bowlers must be USBC Youth members as well as bowlers who are members of youth leagues within the houses of the Lower Delaware Association (Milford, Eagle, Bryan's and Doverama) in order to bowl the Lower Delaware Tournaments.
2. Singles and all events will be broken into two divisions based on average. Division A will be averages 135 & over. Division B will be average 134 and under.
3. Doubles will be broken into two divisions based on combined average of the two bowlers. Division A will be combined average of 270 and over. Division B will be combined average of 269 and under.
4. A bowler's first 3 game set for singles and first 3 game set for doubles will be what is counted for their all events score.
5. Multiple entries will be accepted. However, for singles, a bowler can only receive one award for their highest placing. In doubles, a team of the same two bowlers may only receive one award for their highest placing. In doubles, a bowler may only receive more than one award if they bowl with different partners.
6. Awards will be given in a ratio of at least 1 in 7 for Singles, Doubles and All Events.
7. Averages: The average used will be the highest from the following:
 - a. Current as of 10/18/2024 (minimum of 9 games)
 - b. The bowler's 2023-2024 book average,
 - c. If a bowler does not have either of these two averages, bowler will bowl scratch (230). Rules 319c will be used.
8. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference of the bowlers' average and 230.
9. All decisions of the tournament director will be final unless an appeal is filed in accordance with USBC rule 329.
10. Errors in average or handicap will be automatically corrected.
11. All scholarship awards are managed through the USBC SMART account.
12. The division classification for all events will be based on the entering average for the singles/doubles event. Handicap for all events will be calculated for each event separately based on the entering average for that event.
13. Bowlers participating in this tournament are not permitted to drink alcohol, use tobacco, or use electronic cigarettes at any time during the competition.
14. Dress code: Pants/Shorts must be worn at the waist. Shirts must cover the midriff. Bowlers may not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.
15. Late bowlers may start with the current frame in progress. A zero will be given for all missed frames.
16. Returned checks are subject to a \$45 NSF charge and that person will no longer be allowed to write checks to LDUSBC.
17. Anything not covered will be governed by USBC playing rules.
