## **RULES**

- 1. All bowlers must be sanctioned through USBC.
- 2. Tournament consists of one sanctioned youth bowler and one sanctioned adult bowler.
- 3. Averages should be the higher of 2023-2024 season or current average (please bring proof of current season average) minimum 12 game average for youth and 21 games for adults.
  - a. If a bowler does not have either of these two averages, bowler will bowl scratch (230). Rules 319c will be used.
- 4. Each Bowler will bowl 3 games and handicap will be based on 90% of 460 combined average.
- 5. Tournament is broken into 4 divisions based on team average
  - a. Division A 360 and above
  - b. Division B 300 359
  - c. Division C 240 299
  - d. Division D 239 and below
- 6. All decisions of the tournament director will be final unless an appeal is filed in accordance with USBC rule 329.
- 7. Errors in average or handicap will be automatically corrected.
- 8. Payout will be 1 in 6 per division, with minimum 1<sup>st</sup> place payout with Youth Bowler being awarded Scholarship. Adult bowlers awarded monetarily.
- 9. All scholarship awards are managed through the USBC SMART account.
- 10. Bowlers participating in this tournament are not permitted to drink alcohol, use tobacco, or use electronic cigarettes at any time during the competition.
- 11. Dress code: Pants/Shorts must be worn at the waist. Shirts must cover the midriff. Bowlers may not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.
- 12. Late bowlers may start with the current frame in progress. A zero will be given for all missed frames.
- 13. Returned checks are subject to a \$45 NSF charge and that person will no longer be allowed to write checks to LDUSBC.
- 14. Anything not covered will be governed by USBC playing rules.
