Rules – 2025-2026 Diane Beenick Memorial Team Tournament

- 1. All bowlers must be USBC Youth members as well as bowlers who are members of youth leagues within the state of Delaware in order to bowl the Lower Delaware Tournaments.
- 1. Team events will be broken into two divisions based on average. Division A will be averages 405 & over. Division B will be average 404 and under.
- 2. The bowlers' first 3 game set for a team will be what is counted for their all events score.
- 3. Multiple entries will be accepted. However, a bowler can only receive one award for their highest placing. In teams, a team of the same three bowlers may only receive one award for their highest placing. A team having at least one different participant on their team can place in the awards.
- 4. Awards will be given in a ratio of at least 1 in 7 for Teams and All Events.
- 5. Averages: The average used will be the highest from the following:
 - a. Current as of 11/15/2025 (minimum of 9 games)
 - b. The bowler's 2024-2025 book average,
 - c. If a bowler does not have either of these two averages, bowler will bowl scratch (230). Rules 319c will be used.
- 6. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference of the bowlers' average and 230.
- 7. All decisions of the tournament director will be final unless an appeal is filed in accordance with USBC rule 329.
- 8. Errors in average or handicap will be automatically corrected.
- 9. All scholarship awards are managed through the USBC SMART account.
- 10. The division classification for all events will be based on the entering average for the singles/doubles event. Handicap for all events will be calculated for each event separately based on the entering average for that event.
- 11. Bowlers participating in this tournament are not permitted to drink alcohol, use tobacco, or use electronic cigarettes at any time during the competition.
- 12. Dress code: Pants/Shorts must be worn at the waist. Shirts must cover the midriff. Bowlers may not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.
- 13. Late bowlers may start with the current frame in progress. A zero will be given for all missed frames.
- 14. Returned checks are subject to a \$45 NSF charge and that person will no longer be allowed to write checks to LDUSBC.
- 15. Anything not covered will be governed by USBC playing rules.

Rules – 2025-2026 Pee Wee Singles Tournament

- 1. All Pee Wees will bowl 2 games and use their current average as of 11/15/2025 (minimum of 8 games) or the bowlers 2024-2025 Pee Wee book average.
- 2. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference of the bowlers' average and 230.
- 3. All other rules apply from Youth Singles, Doubles, and Team.
- 4. Awards will be given in a ratio of at least 1 in 5.
- 5. Anything not covered will be governed by USBC playing rules.
